- Advanced Manufacturing



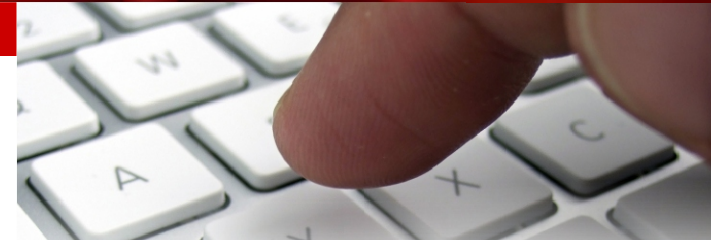
Benefits of Internship
